- **Committee Reports.**
 - New Market Expansion Committee No formal report was made.
 - o Bob Lupton reported that both new membership and conference attendance were down.
 - o Chuck Patti suggested ads on the website
 - o An international call for papers was suggested.
 - o A PDF application form was suggested by Bob Lupton
 - An international conference was discussed. Chuck Patti and James Reardon were going to explore options in Singapore and Eastern Europe respectively.

 - Other programs (doctorial sessions, teaching workshops & development workshops) were discussed.
 - Archivist Committee No formal report was made.
 - o Jack Schibrowsky proposed that Bruce Lammers be contacted to head this committee.

> 2005 Conference Reports

- Richard Lapidus, Vice President reported the following:
 - o 54 papers submitted for the competitive sessions, 47 were accepted.
 - o Lack of volunteerism resulted in no discussants this year.
 - The best paper was awarded to Dennis Clayson for his paper "Student Evaluation of Instruction: The Theoretical Effects of Leniency and Reciprocity."
- Ken Chapman, President-elect reported the following:
 - o 12 Special session papers were submitted, 9 were accepted.
 - o There were no roundtable discussions at this year's conference.
- Exhibits and Sponsors, Beverlee Anderson, President reported the following:
 - o There were five publishers represented at the conference.
 - o Sponsorship money was approximately \$8225.

 Jack Schibrowsky, Immediate Past President announced that Nancy Frontczak would be this year's recipient.

- Robert Lupton, Secretary Treasurer reported the following:
 - o 108 participants had formally registered for the conference.
 - o \$28,000 was generated from registrations.
 - o 52 people had purchased tickets for the Sea World dinner.
